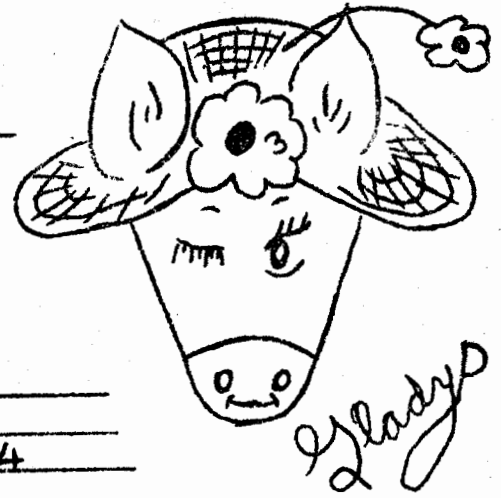

CONGRATULATIONS- to Nancy (boo-hoo!) who is engaged to George. Their wedding is planned for the ~~summer~~fall.

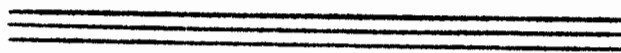
