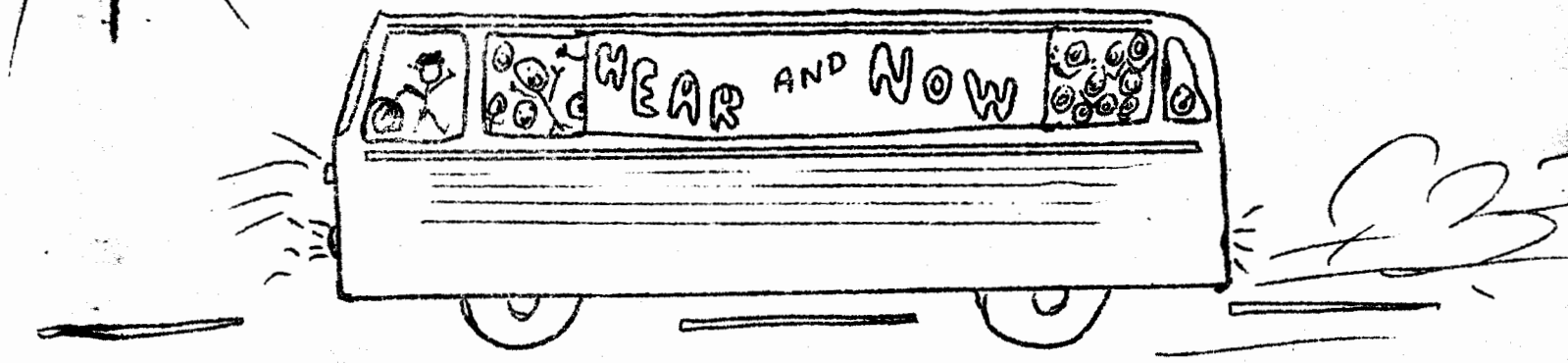
Of all of her memories of the group one of her fondest is crying in the freezer over "all that food".
